Please read and place you initials in front of each rule to indicate that you will comply by the rules.

The participants of the Town of Farmville summer swim programs must adhere to all rules listed below. The University reserves the right to remove and/or deny use of the facility to anyone who violates these rules. Participants utilize all facilities “at your own risk”.

- Swim only when a lifeguard is on duty.
- Running and disruptive play is prohibited.
- Program supervision is the responsibility of the Town of Farmville.
- Appropriate swimming attire is required in the pool. On-deck attire includes non-marking clean shoes, shirts and shorts.
- Personal locks are permitted on the lockers but **MUST** be removed at the end of each session along with personal items in the lockers. Locks not removed daily will be removed and discarded and personal items left behind will be discarded.
- Band-aids, adhesive tape, and any type of bandage must be removed prior to entering the pool.
- Animals are prohibited unless assisting others.
- Smoking and tobacco substances are prohibited.
- Gum, foods and beverages are prohibited in ALL pool areas.
- No personal water toys are allowed in the pool.
- Any posting of materials is prohibited.
- Bicycles, rollerblades and skateboards are prohibited.
- Weapons of all types are prohibited.
- All county, state, and federal laws will apply as needed.
- Any display of poor conduct, abusive language, fighting, or willful destruction of University property will result in loss of facilities use privileges. If appropriate, other actions will be taken including disciplinary and legal action.
- Access to the facilities will be granted with valid identification.
