MAY 2025

The Town of Farmville will have its Spring Cleanup on Monday, May 12, 2025. Town residents **MUST** have all items at the curbside by 7:30 a.m. on May 12th. This cleanup provides pickup of items not normally picked up, such as furniture, appliances, carpet, bedding, and building materials. Any loose items must be boxed or bagged to be collected. Items must be in a container that is to be thrown away. Rocks, cement blocks, bricks and loose dirt will not be picked up.

Separate brush from other items such as bags, metal, furniture, etc. Recyclables should also be separate from all other debris. Motor oil needs to be in a capped, labeled container marked "Motor Oil." Old paint must be hardened (no liquid paint will be picked up). No vehicle batteries or hazardous materials will be picked up.

The Town will also be recycling electronic items. Please separate these recyclable items from all other items. The following are examples of recyclable electronic items: computers, cell phones, televisions, video games, microwaves, stereos and speakers, and other small electronics.

All Town residents and businesses that have items are encouraged to call in for this pick up by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 9, 2025. If you have any questions or requests for collection, call (434) 392-3331.

The above budget includes a real estate tax rate of \$0.22 cents per \$100.00 of assessed value, a personal property tax rate (business only) of \$1.50 per \$100.00 of assessed value, a \$0.27 cent per pack cigarette tax rate, and a 7 percent tax rate on amount paid for meals and lodging within the Town of Farmville limits.
