The Town of Farmville has a new staff member to lead our Department of Public Works. Stephen Edwards was hired as the Director of Public Works effective June 1, 2025.



Stephen has over twenty-five years of experience in the civil engineering and environmental fields, with over sixteen years in local government, and is proficient in site plan design and review, construction management, stormwater management, project management, land development, capital improvement projects, and environmental laws and regulations.

Stephen comes from Dinwiddie County, where he served as the Environmental Administrator, overseeing the County's environmental program, and was the project manager for the County's construction projects. He has also worked for the City of Hopewell Public Works as the Stormwater Program Manager and for the City of Colonial Heights Public Works as a Senior Engineering Technician. Before his experience in local government, Stephen worked for both Timmons Group and KBJW as an engineering designer.

He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Environmental Management with a minor in Occupational Safety and Health from Columbia Southern University. He is certified as a Dual Combined Administrator, Stormwater Inspector, and Preparer of Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan.
