## FALL CLEAN-UP IS COMING!!!

The Town of Farmville Fall Cleanup will be on **Thursday, October 9, 2025.**

Town residents will need to have all items at the curbside no later than **7:30 am on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025.**

This Cleanup provides pickup of items not normally picked up, listed below. Any loose items must be boxed or bagged to be collected. If you set it out at the curb it will be thrown away. Recyclables & brush must be separated from throw away items.



### Items that will be picked up:

Furniture, Carpet, Appliances, Bedding, Building materials, Recyclables (separated), Brush (separated) Motor oil (must be labeled "motor oil" & stored in capped container), Hardened paint (must be hardened) Electronics (to be recycled), and Tires.

### Items that will NOT be picked up:

Rocks, Cement Blocks, Bricks, Loose Dirt, Vehicle Batteries, Hazardous Materials, and Liquid Paint.

### Items that are set out to be picked up are at the discretion of the Sanitation Superintendent.

All items collected during this campaign become the property of the Town of Farmville, who is therefore responsible for proper disposal. If you have any questions on items to be picked up, please contact (434) 392-3331. You do not need to call to a request pickup.

Tuesday residential garbage collection, and Wednesday business recycle and residential cardboard call-in

#### Thursday, October 16, 2025 -

Wednesday residential garbage collection, and Residential curbside recycle

#### Friday, October 17, 2025 -

Normal business garbage and cardboard collection

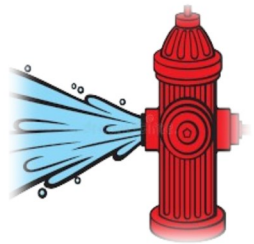
Remember to set your clocks back one hour at 2 a.m. local time on Sunday, November 2, 2025.
