ALL BUSES ARE EQUIPPED WITH WHEELCHAIR LIFTS FOR THE DISABLED. PLEASE ASK THE DRIVER FOR HELP IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE WHEN BOARDING THE BUS.

THE FARMVILLE AREA BUS IS SPONSORED JOINTLY BY THE TOWN OF FARMVILLE AND LONGWOOD UNIVERSITY, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF RAIL AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION.

BLUE LINE

The Blue Line travels around the Town of Farmville in a more or less counter-clockwise direction starting at Spring and Osborne Streets in the north, passing through downtown and the shopping centers, and down to the motels, restaurants, and bowling alley at the south end of town; it returns via Griffin Boulevard and Southside Community Hospital. On alternate trips, it visits Milwood Village (call in only) and The Woodland.

A round trip takes about an hour. Scheduled stops are denoted by a ● on the map and times for many of the stops are shown on the reverse side. Arrival times at other stops can be computed by adding a few minutes to the schedule at the timed stop before yours.

The last round trip on weekdays is the 5:26 p.m. from Osborne and Spring, ending at Third and Virginia at 6:13 p.m. Saturday service begins at Osborne and Spring at 8:04 a.m. and ends at Third and Virginia at 6:13 p.m.

If no passenger is at the stop, the bus will not stop. No bus will proceed from a stop more than 2 minutes ahead of schedule. Bus schedules do not permit waiting for passengers.

Loading assistance is provided to wheelchair users. The driver is required to remain on the bus at all other times.

NO SMOKING, DRINKING, EATING OR FOOD in open containers allowed. Please help us keep our buses clean. Carry-on items (groceries, laundry, packages, etc.) are limited to what passengers can bring on and take off the bus by themselves as they board or deboard. Excessive items are not allowed; no assistance will be provided, and the bus will not wait at stops.

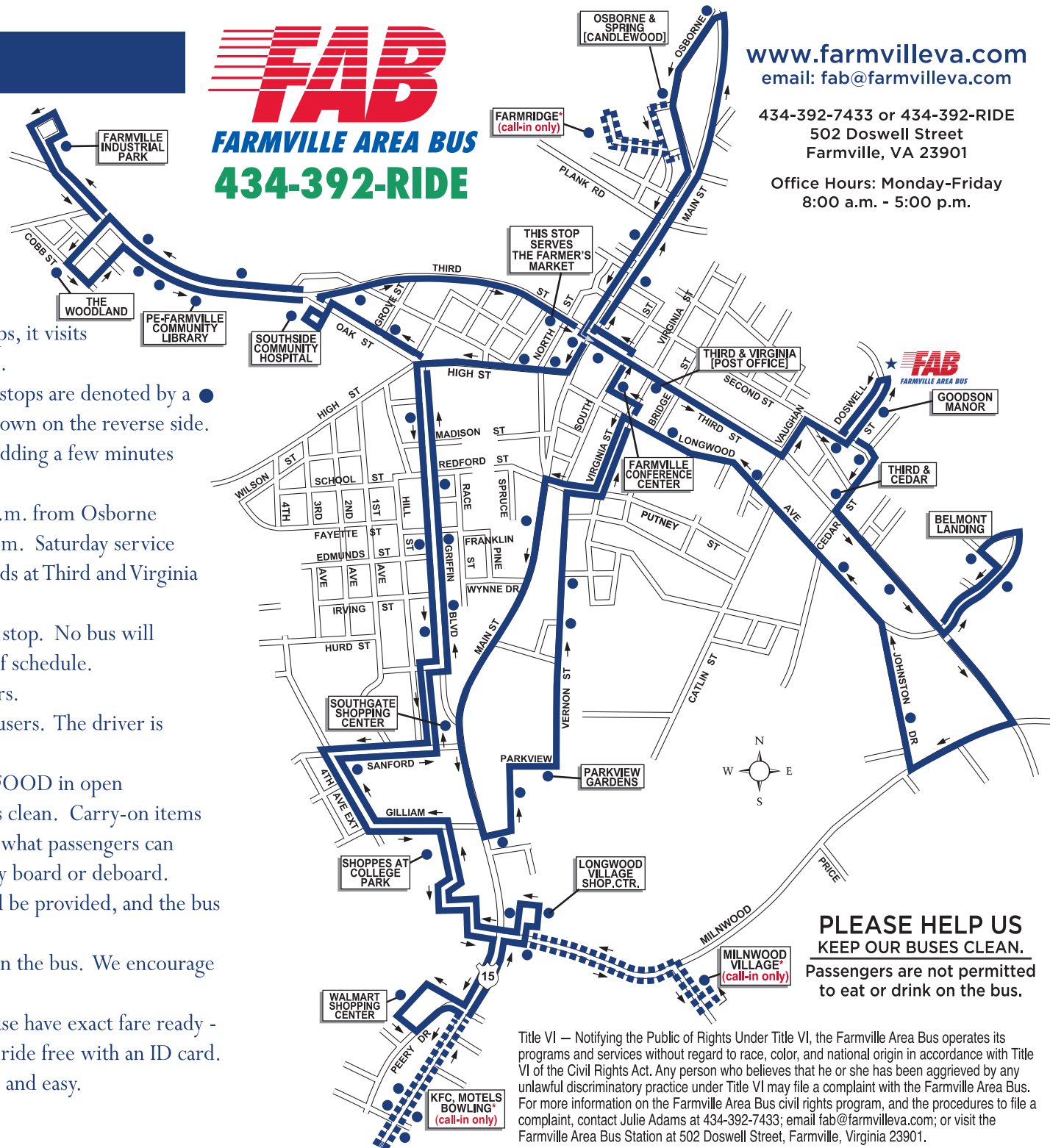
For passenger safety, seat belts are provided on the bus. We encourage passengers to buckle up every time they ride.
